Membership Terms and Conditions

Membership Term: Memberships run from May 1 through October 31.

Hours: Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday **12 noon – Sunset.**
Saturday, Sunday and Holidays **10 am – Sunset**

Safety Obligations of Members: Members must operate and navigate Courageous Sailing Center boats safely and with good judgment. Additionally, members agree to:

- **attend a member orientation seminar before beginning the sailing season**
- be aware of and respect present and future weather conditions, time of tides and sunset
- make a preliminary safety and equipment inspection of the boat and advise Courageous Sailing Center immediately of any discrepancy or damage
- members and all guests must wear a life jacket when sailing
- take one throw-able cushion and a paddle when sailing
- have everyone on board wear boating footwear (non-marking soles)
- always have and use appropriate nautical charts, VHF radio or cellular phone, and an anchor when traveling beyond Castle Island
- always maintain a proper lookout for other vessels
- ensure boats are returned to the Courageous Sailing Center dock by sunset
- not consume alcoholic beverages before or while operating Courageous Sailing Center boats

Damages and Services: An optional \$50 payment waives your financial responsibility for physical damage to our boats while in your care and custody. No waiver of damage liability shall be effective until the damage waiver payment is received. Please note, the damage waiver payment does not waive your financial responsibility for towing services and damage resulting from running aground.

Repair/Replacement: Members who do not pay the \$50 damage waiver fee are liable for repair/replacement of the following: lost or damaged equipment, halyard retrieval, standby rescue, towing and salvage services, and other services to the vessels caused by operator's use/misuse except normal wear. Rates: Equipment at our cost, third party charges as received.

Refund Policy: Refund requests must be submitted in writing to Courageous Sailing Center before May 1st, 2007 to be considered.

Interruption of operations: Memberships remain in effect and running continuously whenever Courageous Sailing Center's operations are interrupted due to storms, fires, or other disasters. Courageous Sailing Center reserves the right to make adjustments at its discretion subject to its ability to recover damages.

Release of Liability: Members acknowledge that they are aware of the potential hazards of the sport of sailing, and will abide by the safety obligations outlined above and hold The Courageous Sailing Center, Inc., the City of Boston, Parks and Recreation, their agents, officers and employees harmless from any and all claims of injury arising from members or guests operation of Courageous Sailing Center vessels. All members and their guests must sign waiver form before sailing.

Boat Availability: Boats are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Reservations are strongly recommended. Most boats are reserved on weekdays from 9:30 am – 3:30 pm for our youth sailing program.

Corporate Memberships: Any employee with a company ID may sail with other employees of that company and/or guests (Corporate membership prices include guest pass). Medium and Large Corporate Members may have multiple boats in the water at a time as follows: Medium – up to 2 boats, Large – up to 3 boats. Small Corporate members are limited to one boat in the water at a time. Corporate members are responsible for coordinating usage of membership by employees (proof of employment with company required to be shown at the Courageous Boathouse). **Reservations are strongly recommended for Corporate Members to reserve boats and to confirm that other employees have not already reserved boats exceeding the limit.**
